Rules and Regulations

- SCHOOLING will be permitted only in areas designated for schooling.
- Riders and trainers may walk the course during designated course walk times only which will be posted at the show office.
- ASTM/SEI certified headgear is required at all times when mounted.
- THERE IS NO SCHOOLING IN DERBY RINGS. If any schooling does occur in derby rings, entry will be eliminated, and no refunds will be issued.
- Scratches/ Add slips must be summitted at the Secretary Stand before the
 derby. Once derby order of go has been posted no additional adds will be
 accepted. Derby order of go will be posted 20 minutes prior to the start of each
 derby at the office and in-gate.
- All entries will occur a \$35.00 office fee, \$25 grounds /EMT fee and a \$2.00 number.
- Entries Accepted on RingRadar.com or ARHSNJ.com
- Post Entries will be accepted the day of and will be subjected to a \$15.00 post entry fee.
- A valid form of payment must be on file with the show office in order for back numbers to be issued. In addition to Checks, Venmo, Credit Card and Paypal are accepted as payment; a 4% convenience fee will be assessed if paypal or credit card option is utilized.
- All entries must be paid prior to the start of the derby. Entries that are not paid by the start of the derby will be ineligible to compete.
- Derby courses may include gates, coops, walls, brushes, oxers, panels, natural elements and combinations.
- All pets must be kept on a leash at all times.
- Sharps containers will be located at the show office
- No Alcohol is permitted on the Showgrounds
- All Exhibitors are required to wear proper show attire and use appropriate tack for the riding style of the class. All riders are required to wear appropriate boots with a heel.
- It is the responsibility of the Rider to ensure that they are eligible to compete in the classes they are enter. Further Specifications and Questions can be answered at the Secretary Stand.

FROM THE NORTH

Take the GSP S to Exit 123, Get on NJ-18 South in Old Bridge, Follow NJ-18S to NJ-79 S/HWY 79S/S Main Street in Marlboro. Take Exit 25B. Follow NJ-79 S/Hwy 79 S/S Main Street turns into Kozloski road. East Freehold Show Grounds will be on the right in 4.5mi.

FROM NJ TURNPIKE:

Take I-95 N to NJ-33 exit 8 (Hightstown) exit onto NJ-33 East towards freehold, follow NJ-33 East to Halls Mill Road, merge onto Halls Mill Road continue onto Kozloski Road. East Freehold Show Grounds will be on the left in 0.5mi

Leadline Derby

Eligibility: Open to riders 6 years of age or younger

The Leadline Derby is a one-round, beginner-friendly class designed for young riders who are led by a handler. The class emphasizes safety, confidence, and basic horsemanship in a fun and supportive environment.

Class Format:

During the class, riders will remain on lead at all times and may be asked to complete a series of simple tests designed to highlight balance, control, and communication. These may include walking over a rail, walking over a rail in a two-point position, halting from a short trot, walking on a loose rein, navigating through a pathway, and demonstrating a handy track at the walk. Judging will focus on rider poise, comfort in the saddle, basic equitation, horse behavior, and overall presentation.

New Rider Derby Entry Fee \$50.00

Eligibility: Open to junior and amateur riders of all ages who are comfortable riding independently and has not jumped fence height 2' or higher. Trotting the derby course is welcomed and encouraged.

The New Rider Derby is a one-round class designed for beginner riders ready to navigate a course of ground rails and cross rails. The class emphasizes rhythm, position, and safe riding over fences in a derby-style format.

Class Format:

The class will consist of one round over a course of 5 to 9 fences, arranged in a derby-style layout. The course may feature natural elements such as flower boxes, brush, or logs, along with handy options like rollbacks, walk throughs, and long approaches. Riders may be asked to demonstrate specific skills including trotting over ground rails, navigating a handy track, executing a halt and rein back, and approaching a single fence from a longer distance. These elements are designed to showcase rider control, rhythm, and adaptability.

The course may feature natural elements such as flower boxes, brush, or logs, along with handy options like rollbacks, trot fences, and long approaches. Riders may be asked to demonstrate specific skills including riding a trot fence, navigating a handy track, executing a halt after a fence, and approaching a single fence from a longer distance. These elements are designed to showcase rider control, rhythm, and adaptability.

Eligibility: Open to horses or ponies of all ages who have not shown at a fence height higher then 3'.

The 2'6 Hunter Derby is a two round class designed to highlight smoothness, style, and rider effectiveness over a course of 2'6 fences with 3' high options.

Class Format:

FIRST ROUND The first round shall be judged on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality and substances, and movement. After the judge's base score is given, one (1) point will be added for each high option fence jumped. The Option Bonus Score of one additional point must be awarded even if there is a refusal, rail down or loss of good jumping style at the higher height option fence, providing that the horse does jump the higher height option fence. The top 10 Horses will return for the second round in reverse order of scores.

SECOND ROUND The second round (Handy Round) shall be judged on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality and substance, movement, brilliance, and handiness. Handiness is defined as ground saving movement without adversely affecting performance or style. Handiness and brilliance are taken into account in the judges. The Option Bonus Score of one additional point must be awarded even if there is a refusal, rail down or loss of good jumping style at the higher height option fence, The total scores from each round will be added together to obtain the final score for each horse.

Eligibility: Open to all horses or ponies of all ages.

Ribbons will be awarded to 1st through 6th place in each of the two classes within every division. Prize money will be distributed to the top four overall finishers in each division. To qualify for prize money, riders must complete both rounds.

Divisions may be combined based on entry numbers. Full prize money will be awarded if a division receives at least six entries.

Elementary Jumper: 18" – 2' w/ 2'3" Option Fence Itty Bitty Jumper: 2'0" – 2'3" w/ 2'6" Option Fence Novice Jumper: 2'6" – 3'0" w/ 3'3" Option Fence

The first round will be judged on optimum time and faults. The second round will be judged on the rider's equitation. During the Equitation round riders who ride the increased height option fence will be awarded 2 extra points for that rounds overall score if the fence is knocked 1 extra point will be given. Riders who earn the most points over the two rounds will determine final standings.

Additional Information:

- Stadium jumps will be used to create a course that is scored based upon a combination of time, faults, and rider equitation
- 10 14 Stadium jump course
- 2 height option fence
- Courses start and finish with a single stadium fence
- Optimum time will be unique to each course/level
- Riding order will be determined by riders back number for both rounds.


